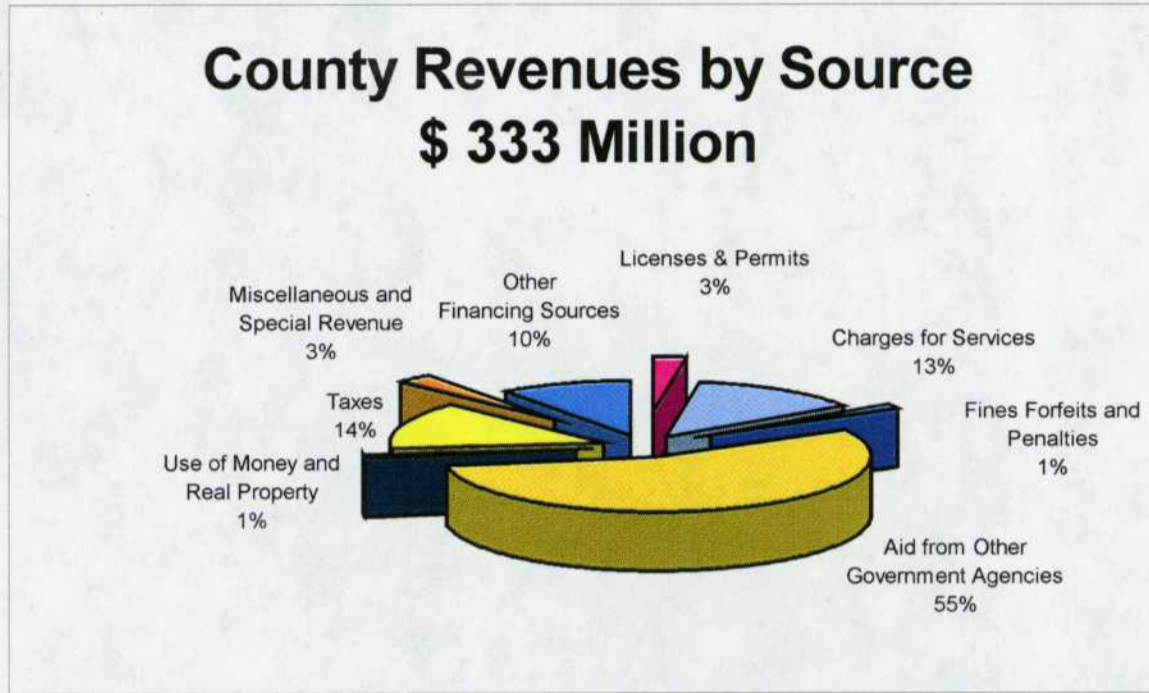


- The next chart shows the revenues by source that support the general and special purpose fund types.



The chart above shows the 55% of revenues are derived from the State of California or the Federal Government. This chart demonstrates the extent of mandated State and Federal programs that are carried out by county government. The difference between the total budget by function, presented in the first chart, and total revenues by source is the unexpended balance from the previous year and cancellation of reserves.

- The following chart reflects the net county cost as percentages by functional area of the general fund financed from local revenue sources. The local revenue sources are derived from local property taxes, sales taxes, motor vehicle in lieu taxes, interest earnings, transient occupancy taxes and other.
