



How To Be Successful On Probation



- Report to your Probation Officer within 5 days of your release from custody. If your P.O. is unavailable, ask to speak to the *Officer of the Day*. You may be asked to fill out a *Drop In Sheet*. On the *Drop In Sheet*, indicate who you spoke with.
- Find out who your Probation Officer is and call them. Leave your current telephone number and address. If you do not have a permanent residence, leave an address and telephone number where you can be reached. Any address change must be reported immediately.
- Do not leave the area without prior approval from your P.O. In order to travel out of State, you will need to get a Travel Permit from your P.O. or the Officer of the Day.
- If you are arrested or cited for a new offense, contact your P.O. within 24 hours. If your P.O. is unavailable leave a voice mail message.
- If you need to find out who your Probation Officer is, contact Reception at 454-2150 or 763-8070
- **Remain in contact with your Probation Officer at all times!** You are better off staying in contact through your challenges than having a warrant issued for your arrest due to non-compliance. Failure to report will result in a warrant request.
