## Current Projects and On-Going Programs

### Youth Activities & Community Facilities

1. In partnership with the County Parks Department, planning for the construction of the following **NEIGHBORHOOD AND COMMUNITY PARK FACILITIES**:
  - a. The Farm Park Community Center and Neighborhood Park
  - b. Felt Street Park
  - c. Floral Park Renovation
  - d. Chanticleer Avenue Park
  - e. Moran Lake Park Habitat and Park Improvements
  - f. Anna Jean Cummings Park Improvements
  - g. Simpkins Family Swim Center Renovations
2. In partnership with Community Bridges and the Volunteers Center of Santa Cruz County, building the **LIVE OAK RESOURCE CENTER** on 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue

### Public Safety, Safe Walking and Biking Routes

1. Fund and support **GRAFFITI ABATEMENT PROGRAMS** within Live Oak and Soquel
2. In partnership with Public Works complete design and construction of **IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS** on:
  - a. East Cliff Drive Bluff Stabilization and Parkway in Pleasure Point (32nd to 41st Avenues)
  - b. East Cliff Drive 17th to 32nd Avenues
  - c. East Cliff Drive 9th to 12th Avenues
  - d. Twin Lakes Beachfront (East Cliff Drive 5th to 9th Avenues)
  - e. Soquel Avenue Sidewalk Infill (City limits to 7th Avenue)
  - f. Soquel Avenue Improvements (Soquel Drive to 17th Avenue)
  - g. Daubenbiss Avenue Sidewalk Infill (West Walnut to Soquel Drive)
  - h. Eaton Street (Murray Street Bridge to 7<sup>th</sup> Ave.)
  - i. Cabrillo College Drive
3. In partnership with Public Works complete **Nova/Bain Neighborhood Traffic Study**
4. Fund the **PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM** within Live Oak and Soquel
5. Continue **consultation with Sheriff's Department** and Central Fire during design of new parks and other public facilities
